IT'S STARTING TO GET SERIOUS

The long-awaited first round of World Supersport finally begins for Andrea Mantovani, in the Australian setting of the Phillip Island circuit, riding the Yamaha R6 of Team Evan Bros.

A debut awaited by the rider of the Ravenna Motoclub Only Two Wheels, who for the first time puts his wheels on this track, the scene of many Superbike and MotoGP grand prix.

New bike and new track are two variables of no small importance for a Rooky rider, in his first world experience in the Supersport category.

"Now it's a matter of measuring one's potential step by step, without getting caught up in haste, trying to consolidate the experience gained round after session", these are the statements of Andrea, who has already shown in the tests on Monday and Tuesday a remarkable progression and a constant improvement.

The team is by his side, they are all very motivated to do well.

"I'm very excited ahead of this first round of the season. Being here, together with a team like this, is a source of pride, so I want to give my best. Certainly a difficult challenge awaits us, but the tests have been positive and so we can start this weekend with optimism".

"A new season is beginning, and this is always exciting for me and for the whole team. We are aware that it will be a challenging season, but the ingredients to achieve good results are not lacking. Andrea is working hard and working in the right way, so we are on the right track. Certainly the tests carried out on this track have helped both us and all the other teams, so we just have to wait for the first tests to understand the values in the field".

The Phillip Island weekend will start as usual on Friday, with the first two free practice sessions. Saturday will be the time of Superpole and Race 1, while Sunday Race 2 will complete the weekend program. As for Italy, also in 2023 the Superpole and the two races will be visible live on Sky Sport MotoGP, Sky channel 208.
